By vote of the 1981 convention, a Founders Award was set aside to honor a North Carolina woman who may or may not be a member of The Delta Kappa Gamma Society International and who has made an outstanding contribution to the improvement to the quality of human life through education, research, publications, or service. The first recipient, Dr. Laura Anderton conducted cancer research and studies on birth defects. The last and eighteenth recipient, Dr. Janis Meek, NC State Consultant: NC Dept. of Public Instruction, Career & Technical Education.

The award, the highest honor Eta State can bestow upon a woman, is presented at the convention the second year of the biennium. Our next convention will be held May 3 - 5, 2019 in Hickory, North Carolina. Your chapter or individual DKG members have a wonderful opportunity to nominate a Tar Heel woman for this distinguished award.
