*Rose Bud Award*

*Rose Bud -noun - a young rose whose petals have not yet opened fully*

Chapters must complete at least 10 items to receive award

- Sent Treasurer's Report to State Treasurer by 8/1
- State Treasurer received all chapter dues and fees by 8/15
- Form 990N submitted to IRS by 11/15
- Sent President's Report to State President by 2/1
- Chapter President or designee attended NC DKG Fall Executive Board Meeting
- Participated in New Chapter Leaders Training (Even Years only)
- Four or more Newsletters provided to members
- Chapter held a *minimum* of FOUR quality programs focusing on the NC Vision Statement and/or Purposes (please submit brief description of four programs presented in chapter meetings)
- Chapter has program/support for beginning teachers (Please provide a brief explanation)
- Chapter Executive Board held at least 2 meetings
- Chapter participated in a community service project (not individual/personal service) (please provide description)
- Chapter Strategic plan approved and maintained by members

- Chapter participated in a multichapter event

## Beyond the Chapter

- Chapter member(s) participated in State Convention
- Chapter member (s) volunteered at State Convention
- Chapter members(s) participated in NC DKG Leadership Development Seminar (odd years)
- Chapter member(s) participated in International Conference/Convention
